


H NEW IN 2020

Public Affairs and Marketing Network (PAMN) Membership

(PAMN) is a cooperative venture of academically based comprehensive, clinical, basic and consortium cancer centers as designated by the National Cancer Institute (NCI) or that are members of the Association of American Cancer Institutes (AACI) The Network works in close association with the NCI's Office of Media Relations and Public Affairs to further public awareness of cancer research, prevention, detection and treatment. The Network was established to share information and resources among the communications and marketing professionals at cancer centers to enhance understanding of the nation's cancer research effort; and to collectively address critical issues of common concern. Melanie Meyer was invited to join the Physician Relations Affinity Group as part of PAMN's outreach, building a physician relations network.

Rural Health Association of Arkansas

The Winthrop Rockefeller Institute's Rural Health Summit COMMITtee submitted HRSA planning grant for the Rural Health Association of Arkansas' first year and awarded \$100,000. The Board of Directors formed and Melanie Meyer serves on it, co-chairing student committee initiatives, including the Student Fieldtrips and bi-monthly ARCOM, NYIT and UAMS rural interest student meetings. A Blue & You Grant was submitted for years two and three. The 1st Annual Rural Health Association of Arkansas Conference was held virtually Sept 2-3.

Physician Visitation Program

Physician Relations & Strategic Development made **2,200+** contacts and visits to Arkansas referring physicians' clinics. Staff delivers UAMS resources and assists with referral issues. A monthly report is emailed to leadership and faculty.

American Association of Physician Liaisons





Automated fax notifications to referring providers

It Development helped Physician Relations create an automated fax to referring providers when appointments are scheduled or when UAMS is unable to contact the patient to schedule.

Communication Program

Physician Relations manages referring provider demographics for the medical center's various IT systems; maintains the centralized point for accurate, accessible referring physician data; and provides auditing functions. **Referring physicians audited: 432**



The Consult

The quarterly clinical newsletter mails to Arkansas physicians and their clinics. It contains new services, Message from the Chief Clinical Officer, LearnOnDemand, Physician Recruitment opportunities, technology and faculty updates with a medical case study. It is emailed internally, distributed at meetings or during visits and posted on Physician Relations website.



EpicCare Link

EpicCare Link enrollment drive April-June

EpicCare Link replaced MD-Link as the secure, web-based portal for referring physicians to track patient progress and treatment at UAMS. **Enrolled: 778 physicians & 1,194 clinic staff**

Epic Failed Fax Mailing Process

Epic had no process for mailing patient care failed faxes. IT Development, Creative Service and Mail Processing helped recreate the program used for the previous RapidFax system. It has been submitted to BioVentures for copyright and patent protection. Next step is a beta testing partner. Failed faxes mailed: 16,280

Faculty Visits to Community Providers

UAMS faculty visits were coordinated with statewide providers to discuss referrals and provide a fast-track to services. **Scheduled: 5 visits with 9 external providers.**

HIPAA Fax Error Notification & Auditing

Physician Relations developed a Physician Fax Correction system for the HIPAA office to notify associated areas regarding patient care communication fax errors and to audit fax errors. Last year, there were 16,280 errors out of 670,704 faxes (> 1%).

In partnership with the Center for Distance Health, the CME Outreach Program now offers Tuesday telecourses with LOD functionality. 


